

## **21<sup>st</sup> IFPRA World Congress, Dublin 2007 - Call for Papers**

The 21<sup>st</sup> IFPRA World Congress will be held in Dublin, Ireland on the following dates:

- **Pre-Congress Tour** - **Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2007**
- **Congress** - **Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> to Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> September 2007**
- **Post Congress Tour** - **Commences on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> September 2007**

Those who wish to make presentations at the congress are invited to submit by email, an abstract of approximately 300 words which relates to the sub-themes no later than the 30th November 2006. The submission must be accompanied with brief curriculum vitae of the author/s of the paper/presentation, including a photograph. All abstracts and final papers should be in MS Word, Times New Roman 11 font.

All submissions will be acknowledged and authors of selected papers will be notified by the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2007 to submit the final paper before the 31<sup>st</sup> January 2007. Deadlines in relation to the submission of the presentation will be notified to the selected authors.

The presentations may be academic or practical papers. In the case of academic papers, they must not have been previously published and will be refereed by an editorial board in cooperation with the Irish Landscape Institute.

Practical papers should focus on case studies relevant to the sub-themes below.

Under the theme of **Parks: A Celebration of Diversity**, a number of **sub-themes** have been identified as follows:
